GENERAL REGULATIONS:

Olympic Autumn Cup 2023 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations, the ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules for Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2022, all relevant ISU Communications and the Classifications of the Estonian Skating Union for season 2023/2024.

Participation in the Olympic Autumn Cup 2023 is open only to competitors and clubs who belong to an ISU Member. All invited clubs, ISU-Members or Clubs, National Figure Skating Federations associated with ISU are invited to the competition in any category and class.

The results for Basic Novice, Intermediate Novice, Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior will be calculated according to latest ISU regulations. All other categories and beginners will be calculated according to the Estonian Figure Skating Union Adapted Classification for Youngsters for season 2023/2024.

As of pandemic situation caused by COVID-19 all participating Teams, Officials and related personnel are responsible of checking active restrictions and guidelines introduced by Estonian Government, Estonian Health Board and the Organizing Committee of the event.

In case of force majeure circumstances, which are beyond of control of the organizer, such as epidemiological situation, war, military operations or political situation or other circumstances,

the organizer is entitled to cancel or postpone the event without having any related penalties. In case of circumstances, which are beyond of control of the organizer, the organizer has the right to change the venue of the competition without having any related penalties.

RESULTS:

- The results for Novice, Junior and Senior will be calculated according to ISU judging system using the judging panel of 5 judges in case of Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior and the judging panel of 3 judges in case of Basic Novice and Intermediate Novice.
- Pre-Chicks Cubs will be calculated according Adapted Classification for Youngsters for season 2023/2024 using judging panel of 3 judges.
- All B class categories will be calculated according to Classification for B class for season 2023/2024 using judging panel of 3 judges.
- All Beginners categories will be calculated according to Classification for Beginners for season 2023/2024 using judging panel of 3 judges.

The Organizers have the right to split categories if the number of participants requires that.

The Organizers have the right to combine categories if the number of participants requires. Result information and detailed protocols will be available on our website: www.olympicfss.com

REGISTRATION OF ENTRIES

Each **club** has the right to enter competitors in any category and class. Please provide your contact information (e-mail, phone) on the entry form.

ENTRY FEE (paid before September 5th, 2023):

Single Skating with one program: 75€

Single Skating with two programs: 90€

Artistic Free Skating: 55€

Late ENTRY FEE (paid between September 6th and 19th):

Single Skating with one program: 85€

Single Skating with two programs: 100€

Artistic Free Skating: 65€

Each club has to pay 100% of the total amount for its participants right after the entry form confirmation, but not later than September 19th, 2023.

The competitor is included in the entry list only after a 100% payment and from that moment can only be substituted by another skater if an emergency cancellation occurs.

We kindly ask the clubs to make one payment for all its participants.

- All registration-related procedures (annulment, changes) must be submitted to the organizer in written form as soon as possible, but no later than **September 24**th , **2023** to the e-mail: olympicfsc@gmail.com
- In case a skater has been entered in the competition, but cannot participate, she/he can be replaced by another skater in the same category and class.

The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason, except when the Organizer has to reduce the entries.

AWARDING:

The three best-placed competitors in each event will be awarded with a cup. All competitors will receive a diploma and a gift.

EXPENCES:

All participants and teams must pay the accommodation and transportation themselves.

MUSIC:

Music must be recorded on CDs or USB. The music medias must be of good quality and labeled clearly with the Competitor's name, Nation, category and the exact music time. Each program must be recorded on a separate disc or USB.

PROTOCOL:

ACCOMMODATION:

The Organizers shall not arrange accommodation.

RESPONSABILITY:

In accordance to ISU Constitution, rule 119, all participants act at their own responsibility.

THE CODE OF ETHICS:

All the skaters, coaches, judges, chaperons should follow the ISU com. 1433. Action against this rule conducts behind itself the disqualification of skater.

An electronic draw will take place on **28.09.2023**, starting orders will be published on our website: www.olympicfss.com

For the Free Skating the starting order will be the reverse order of the result after the Short Program.
