Event time: April 3rd -5th, 2026

Venue of competition: Tondiraba Ice Rink, Main Arena, Rink size 60x30 Varraku 14, Tallinn, Estonia

GENERAL REGULATIONS:

Olympic Spring Cup 2026 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations, the ISU Special Regulations for Figure Skating as well as all pertinent ISU Communications for Figure Skating and the classification of the Estonian Skating Union for season 2025/2026.

Participation in the Olympic Spring Cup 2025 is open only to competitors and clubs who belong to an ISU Member. All invited clubs, ISU-Members or Clubs, National Figure Skating Federations associated with ISU are invited to the competition in any category and class.

The results for Basic Novice, Intermediate Novice, Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior will be calculated according to latest ISU regulations. All other categories and beginners will be calculated according to the Estonian Figure Skating Union Adapted Classification for Youngsters for season 2025/2026.

In case of force majeure circumstances, which are beyond of control of the organizer, such as epidemiological situation, war, military operations or political situation or other circumstances, the organizer is entitled to cancel or postpone the event without having any related penalties. In case of circumstances, which are beyond of control of the organizer, the organizer has the right to change the venue of the competition without having any related penalties.

RESULTS:

- The results for Novice, Junior and Senior will be calculated according to ISU judging system using the judging panel of 5 judges in case of Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior and the judging panel of 3 judges in case of Basic Novice and Intermediate Novice.
- Pre-Chicks Cubs will be calculated according to Classification for A class for season 2025/2026 using judging panel of 3 judges.
- All B class categories will be calculated according to Classification for B class for season 2025/2026 using judging panel of 3 judges.
- All Beginners categories will be calculated according to Classification for Beginners for season 2025/2026 using judging panel of 3 judges.

The Organizers have the right to split categories if the number of participants requires that.

The Organizers have the right to combine categories if the number of participants requires. Result information and detailed protocols will be available on our website: www.olympicfss.com

REGISTRATION OF ENTRIES

Each **club** has the right to enter competitors in any category and class. Please provide your contact information (e-mail, phone) on the entry form.

ENTRY FEE (paid before March 14th, 2026):

Single Skating with one program: 90€ Single Skating with two programs: 110€ Pair Skating with two programs: 110€

Artistic Free Skating single: 60€

Late ENTRY FEE (all entries paid after March 14th, 2026 are declared to be late entry)

All Entry Fee payments received after **March 14th**, **2026** are subject to a late entry fee of 10€ per single skater/couple.

Each club has to pay 100% of the total amount for its participants right after the entry form confirmation, but not later than March 14th, 2026.

The competitor is included in the entry list only after a 100% payment and from that moment can only be substituted by another skater if an emergency cancellation occurs. The OC reserves the right to cancel the Entry of skaters whose entry fee has not been paid by the published deadline

We kindly ask the clubs to make one payment for all its participants.

- All registration-related procedures (annulment, changes) must be submitted to the organizer in written form as soon as possible, but no later than **April 1**st , **2026** to the e-mail: olympicfsc@gmail.com
- In case a skater has been entered in the competition, but can not participate, she/he can be replaced by another skater in the same category and class.

The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason, except when the Organizer has to reduce the entries.

AWARDING:

The three best-placed competitors in each event will be awarded with a cup. All competitors will receive a diploma and a gift.

EXPENCES:

All participants and teams must pay the accommodation and transportation themselves.

MUSIC:

Music must be sent to the e-mail music.olympic.cup@gmail.com by latest March 14h, 2026 if not registrered through Sportity app

Each submission shall be labelled with the name of the ISU Member, the name of the category, the segment and the name(s) of the competitor(s).

The music files must be sent as WAV or MP3 file formats. Any other format is not acceptable.

<u>Please note:</u> Each Competitor must have its own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program in the format of a WAV or MP3 file.

The athlete is responsible for having a license for the music used in their performance. The organizing body or competition host assumes no liability for unlicensed music. In case of a dispute, the athlete (or their representative) must provide proof of licensing upon request.
