ANNOUNCEMENT

Event time: December 2nd - 4th, 2022

Venue of competition: Tondiraba Ice Rink, Main Arena, Rink size 60x30, Varraku 14, Tallinn, Estonia

Organizer: Figure Skating Club Olympic

GENERAL REGULATIONS:

Olympic Winter Cup 2022 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations, the ISU Special Regulations for Figure Skating as well as all pertinent ISU Communications for Figure Skating and the classification of the Estonian Skating Union for season 2022/2023.

Participation in the Olympic Winter Cup 2022 is open only to competitors and clubs who belong to an ISU Member. All invited clubs, ISU-Members or Clubs, National Figure Skating Federations associated with ISU are invited to the competition in any category and class.

The results for Basic Novice, Intermediate Novice, Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior will be calculated according to latest ISU regulations. All other categories and beginners will be calculated according to the Estonian Figure Skating Union Adapted Classification for Youngsters for season 2022/2023.

The competitions follow the principles established by the Estonian Government for preventing the spread of the COVID-19 virus.

As of pandemic situation caused by COVID-19 all participating Teams, Officials and related personnel are responsible of checking active restrictions and guidelines introduced by Estonian Government, Estonian Health Board and the Organizing Committee of the event.

In case of force majeure circumstances, which are beyond of control of the organizer, such as epidemiological situation, war, military operations or political situation or other circumstances, the organizer is entitled to cancel or postpone the event without having any related penalties. In case of circumstances, which are beyond of control of the organizer, the organizer has the right to change the venue of the competition without having any related penalties.

RESULTS:

- The results for Novice, Junior and Senior will be calculated according to ISU judging system using the judging panel of 5 judges in case of Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior and the judging panel of 3 judges in case of Basic Novice and Intermediate Novice.

- Pre-Chicks – Cubs will be calculated according Adapted Classification for Youngsters for season 2022/2023 using judging panel of 3 judges.

- All B class categories will be calculated according to Classification for B class for season 2022/2023 using judging panel of 3 judges.

- All Beginners categories will be calculated according to Classification for Beginners and Adults for season 2022/2023 using judging panel of 3 judges.

The Organizers have the right to split categories if the number of participants requires that. The Organizers have the right to combine categories if the number of participants requires.

REGISTRATION OF ENTRIES

Each **club** has the right to enter competitors in any category and class. Please provide your contact information (e-mail, phone) on the entry form.

Entry forms must be submitted by **November 1st, 2022**. Please address your entry form to **e-mail: olympicwintercup@gmail.com**

ENTRY FEE (paid before November 4th, 2022):

Single Skating with one program: 75€

Single Skating with two programs: 90€

Artistic Free Skating: 55€

Late ENTRY FEE (paid between November 5th and 15th):

Single Skating with one program: 85€

Single Skating with two programs: 100€

Artistic Free Skating: 65€

Each club has to pay **100%** of the total amount for its participants **right after the entry form confirmation**, but not later than **November 15th, 2022**.

The competitor is included in the entry list only after a 100% payment and from that moment can only be substituted by another skater if an emergency cancellation occurs.

We kindly ask the clubs to make one payment for all its participants.

- All registration-related procedures (annulment, changes) must be submitted to the organizer in written form as soon as possible, but no later than **November 24th, 2022** to the e-mail: olympicwintercup@gmail.com
- In case a skater has been entered in the competition, but cannot participate, she/he can be replaced by another skater in the same category and class.
The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason, except when the Organizer has to reduce the entries.

AWARDING:

The three best-placed competitors in each event will be awarded with a medal. All competitors will receive a diploma.

JUDGES:

Each participating Club may nominate one, at least international level judge. The organizer will cover the accommodation and meals. Transportation will be not covered by the organizer.

EXPENCES:

All participants and teams must pay the accommodation and transportation themselves.

MUSIC:

Music must be recorded on CDs or USB. The music medias must be of good quality and labeled clearly with the Competitor's name, Nation, category and the exact music time. Each program must be recorded on a separate disc or USB.

PROTOCOL:

ACCOMMODATION:

The Organizers shall not arrange accommodation.

RESPONSABILITY:

In accordance to ISU Constitution, rule 119, all participants act at their own responsibility.

THE CODE OF ETHICS:

All the skaters, coaches, judges, chaperons should follow the ISU com. 1433. Action against this rule conducts behind itself the disqualification of skater.

DRAW:

An electronic draw will take place on **1.12.2022**, starting orders will be published on our website: www.olympicfss.com

For the Free Skating the starting order will be the reverse order of the result after the Short Program.
